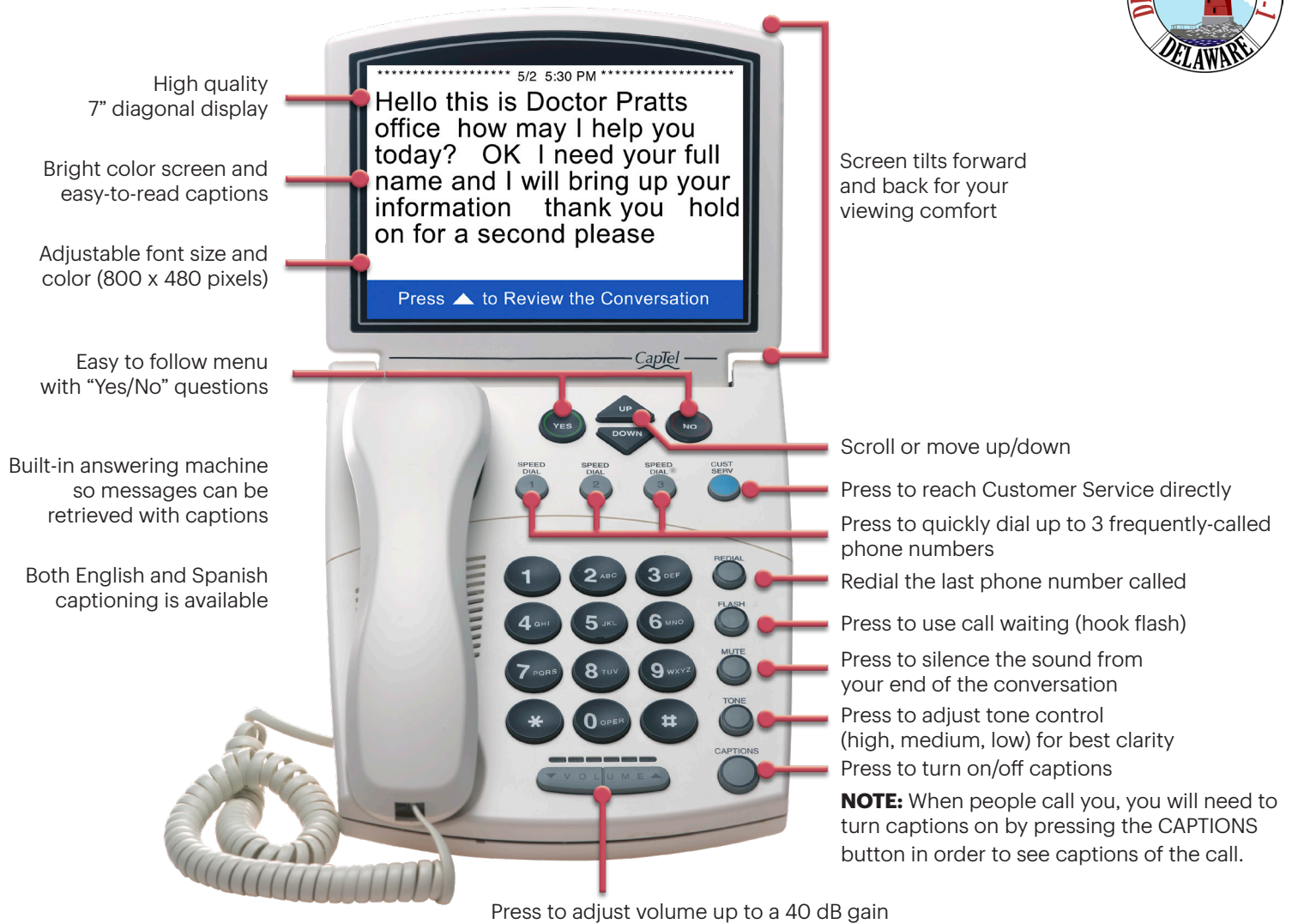

Request a CapTel 840 phone at no cost:

The Delaware Office of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DODHH) administers the CapTel program, which provides access to public telecommunication services for residents of Delaware who have hearing loss and can benefit from captioned telephone conversations, using devices for analog communications.

Applications and documents are available to download at delawarerelay.com/how-to-get-captel. The links at the website contain the procedures to secure this service, and the application form to complete and return to DODHH to get on the list to receive such services.
